- I plan to send report cards and school account billing statements home with the students tomorrow.
- Please regularly remind your students that doing their best work and giving their best effort (which includes completing assignments--on time) will help ensure academic success and progress—and a very proud, pleased, teacher! The crabby Mr. Jenks's version to students who are here 35+ hours a week (full-time) would be, "Do your job!" The encouraging, helpful Mr. Jenks's version from a teacher who wants students to succeed and do well is, "Do your job!" 
