3rd & 4th Classroom

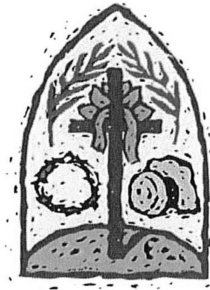
- Are we ready for spring yet?!!!!
