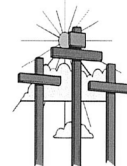
Mrs. Koeritz's 1st & 2nd Classroom

- **It is all about Jesus, the Light of the world!**

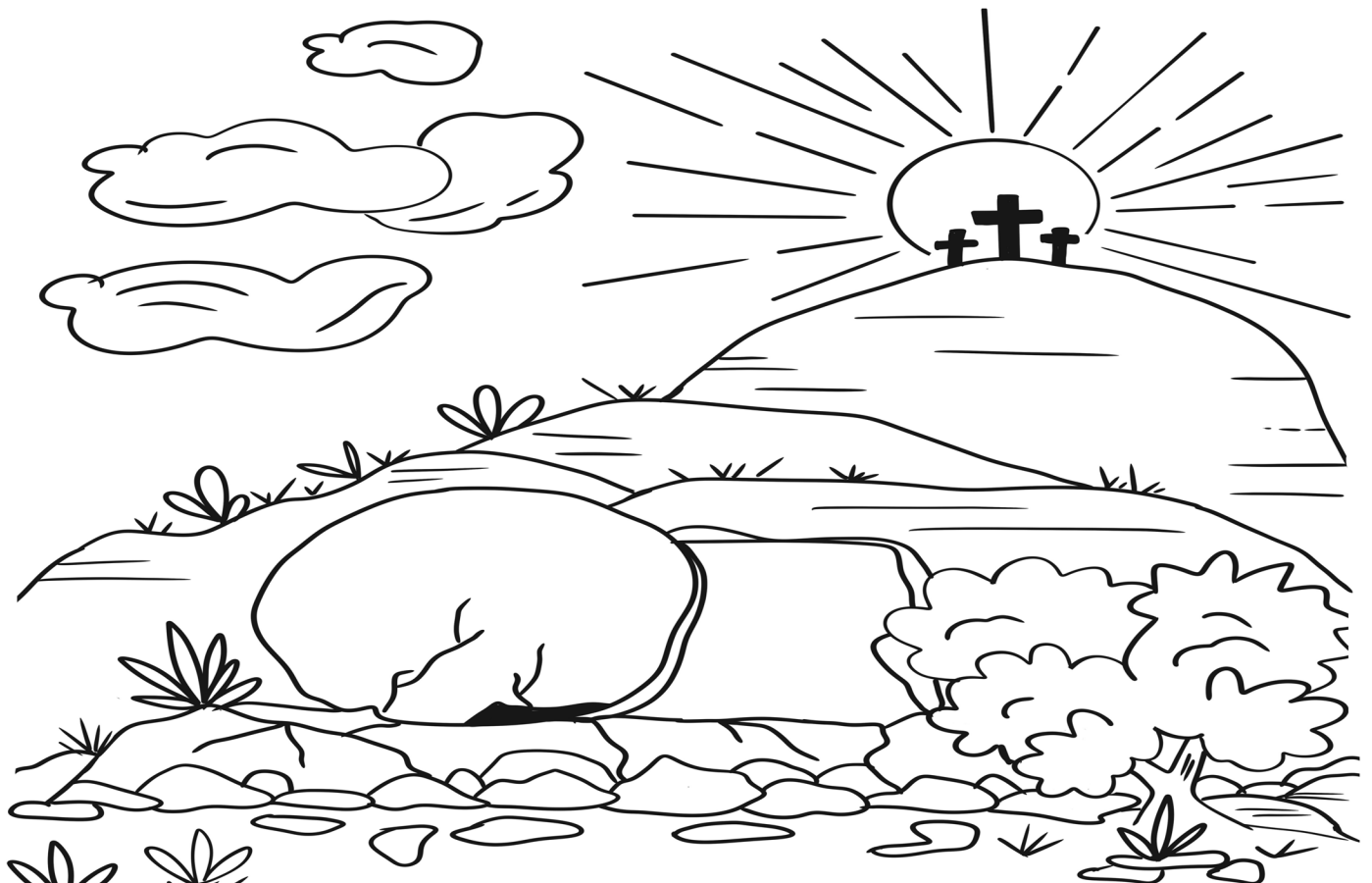
