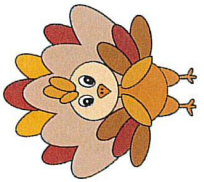
Mrs. Meyer's 5th & 6th Grade Classroom

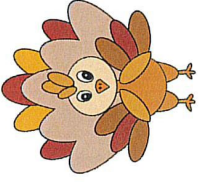

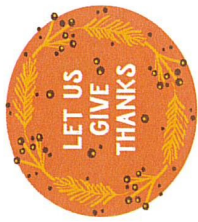
