Connection Corner

Square breathing is a great tool for helping regulate breathing and emotions. Practice breathing in for four seconds, holding your breath for four seconds, exhaling slowly for four seconds, and holding your empty lungs for four seconds. It can help to draw one side of a square during each step. Repeat until feeling calm. This technique can help young and old alike when feeling stressed or upset.

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
